Mae Addysg wedi bod yn flaenoriaeth erioed i Gyngor Sir Ddinbych. Er bod y ffocws wedi bod ar wella cyrhaeddiad a darparu cefnogaeth ar gyfer ein hysgolion, mae'r angen i wella'r cyfleusterau wedi bod yn flaenllaw yn ein hystyriaethau bob amser.

Cafodd Rhaglen Ysgolion yr 21ain Ganrif ei datblygu gan Lywodraeth Cymru mewn partneriaeth ag awdurdodau lleol ledled Cymru. Rhoddodd hyn gyfle i Sir Ddinbych ddechrau cwmpasu rhaglen amlinellol ar gyfer sut y gallai wella adeiladau ei ysgolion.

Cymeradwywyd Cynllun Buddsoddi cyffredinol y Cyngor mewn egwyddor gan Lywodraeth Cymru yn 2011, a roddodd ganiatâd i Sir Ddinbych fanylu ar sut y gallai droi'r weledigaeth hon yn realiti.

Ar ôl etholiadau'r Cyngor Sir yn 2012, cytunodd Sir Ddinbych i gefnogi Cynllun Corfforaethol uchelgeisiol a oedd yn cynnwys ymrwymiad i fuddsoddi dros £90 miliwn i wella perfformiad ym maes addysg ac ansawdd ein hadeiladau ysgol.

Dechreuodd y prosiect hwn o ddifrif ym mis Chwefror 2013 pan wnaethom ddechrau gweithio gyda Willmott Dixon fel contractwr i ddatblygu'r cynlluniau ar gyfer yr ysgol ysblennydd hon. Ochr yn ochr â'r gwaith hwn, cytunwyd ar yr Achos Busnes o dros £24 miliwn o fuddsoddiad gan Sir Ddinbych a Llywodraeth Cymru.

Ar ôl bron i 18 mis o gynllunio, dechreuodd y weledigaeth droi i realiti wrth i'r contractwyr symud ar y safle ym mis Medi 2014.

Mae'r ddwy ysgol wedi rhannu'r daith hon ers 2014 ac rydym i gyd wedi dod at ein gilydd i ddathlu cerrig milltir arwyddocaol ar hyd y ffordd. Ym mis Tachwedd 2014, cynhaliwyd y seremoni torri'r dywarchen lle gallem oll weld y byddai'r adeilad yn dod yn realiti o'r diwedd. Roedd yn bleser cwrdd â disgyblion o'r ddwy ysgol yn y digwyddiad hwn, ac yna seremoni arwyddo'r trawst ym mis Mai 2015 a'r seremoni gosod carreg gopa ym mis Hydref 2015. Yn olaf, agorodd yr adeilad ei ddrysau i'r disgyblion ym mis Ebrill 2016 - ar amser ac o fewn y gyllideb.

Mae'r adeilad newydd yn newyddion gwych ar gyfer cenedlaethau disgyblion y dyfodol, yn ogystal ag adfywiad parhaus Y Rhyl. Mae'r cyfleusterau diweddaraf sy'n cael eu darparu yn dangos ymrwymiad parhaus y Cyngor i ddarparu'r dechrau gorau posibl i'n plant a phobl ifanc mewn amgylchedd modern.

Fel aelod arweiniol, mae wedi bod yn bleser rhannu'r daith hon gydag Ysgol Uwchradd y Rhyl ac Ysgol Tir Morfa, a dymunaf y gorau ar gyfer y dyfodol i'r ddwy ysgol.

Education has always been a priority for Denbighshire County Council. Whilst the focus has been on improving attainment and providing support for our schools, the need to improve the facilities has always been at the forefront of our consideration.

The 21st Century Schools Programme was developed by the Welsh Government in partnership with local authorities across Wales. This gave the opportunity for Denbighshire to scope out an outline programme for how it could improve its school buildings.

The Council's overall Investment Plan was approved in principal by the Welsh Government in 2011 which gave the green light for Denbighshire to detail how it could turn this vision into reality.

After the County Council elections in 2012, Denbighshire agreed to back an ambitious Corporate Plan which included a commitment to invest over £90million to improve performance in education and the quality of our school buildings.

This project started in earnest in February 2013 when we started with work with Willmott Dixon as contractor to develop the designs for this splendid school and alongside this work the Business Case for over £24m investment was agreed by both Denbighshire and the Welsh Government.

After nearly 18 months of planning the vision began to turn to reality as the contractors moved onto site in September 2014.

The two schools have shared this journey since 2014 and we have all come together to celebrate significant milestones along the way. In November 2014 we held the turf cutting ceremony where finally we could all see that the building would soon be a reality. It was a pleasure to meet pupils from both schools at this event followed by the beam signing ceremony in May 2015 and the topping out ceremony in October 2015. Finally the building opened its doors to the pupils in April 2016- on time and on budget.

The new building is great news for future generations of pupils, as well as the continued regeneration of Rhyl. The state of the art facilities that are provided demonstrates the Council's continued commitment to providing the best possible start for our children and young people in modern surroundings.

As a lead member it has been a pleasure to share this journey with Rhyl High School and Ysgol Tir Morfa and I wish both schools all the very best for the future.



Ysgol Tir Morfa

Mae Ysgol Tir Morfa yn ysgol gymunedol arbennig sy'n darparu ar gyfer disgylion sydd ag ystod eang o anghenion dysgu ychwanegol, rhwng 3 a 19 oed. Ym mis Ebrill 2016, symudodd ein disgylion Cyfnod Allweddol 3 a 4, sy'n dilyn Cwricwlwm Cenedlaethol a gefnogir, i'r safle newydd yn Ffordd Grange. Mae pedwar dosbarth yn safle Ffordd Grange, gyda chyfanswm o 45 o ddisgylion.

Ysgol Tir Morfa is a community special school which caters for pupils with a wide range of additional learning needs, aged between 3 and 19 years. In April 2016, our Key Stage 3 and 4 pupils who follow a supported National Curriculum moved into the new premises at Grange Road. There are four classes based at the Grange Road site, totalling 45 pupils.

Ar ôl cyflawni Baglor mewn Addysg yng Ngholeg Addysg Bellach Lerpwl gan arbenigo mewn addysg y blynnyddoedd cynnar, aeth ymlaen i ennill Diploma Uwch mewn Addysg Arbennig yng Ngholeg Caer.

Ymunodd Carol â'r staff yn Ysgol Tir Morfa ym mis Ionawr 1979 ac mae wedi gweld yr ysgol yn datblygu o ysgol ar gyfer anawsterau dysgu cymedrol i'r ddarpariaeth y mae heddiw, sy'n darparu ar gyfer ystod llawer ehangu o anghenion gan gynnwys disgylion ag anghenion dysgu cymhleth ac anghenion meddygol.

Dechreuodd Carol ei gyrfa fel athrawes ddosbarth yn asesu'r blynnyddoedd cynnar, ond aeth ymlaen i ddysgu ar draws yr ystod oedran a daeth yn arweinydd tîm cyn dod yn Bennaeth Cynorthwyol a Dirprwy Bennaeth. Fe'i penodwyd yn Bennaeth ym mis Ionawr 2011 ac mae'n ymddeol ar ddiwedd y tymor hwn ar ôl 37 o flynyddoedd yn yr ysgol yn gweithio fel addysgwr arbennig.

Having achieved a Bachelor of Education at Liverpool College of further Education specialising in early years education she went on to achieve an Advanced Diploma in Special Education through Chester College.

Carol joined the staff at Ysgol Tir Morfa in January 1979 and has seen the school develop from a school for moderate learning difficulties to the provision it is today, providing for a much wider range of needs including pupils with complex learning and medical needs.

Carol started her career as an early years assessment class teacher but went on to teach across the age range and became a team leader before becoming an Assistant Headteacher and Deputy Headteacher. She was appointed Headteacher in January 2011 and is retiring at the end of this term after 37 years at the school and working as a special educator.
